## THE FUTURE TENSE IN FRENCH - REGULAR VERBS

## (a.k.a. the simple future tense)

## When to use it:

- when describing events that are going to happen in the future
- usually when describing future events that may be some way off (i.e. in 5 years' time)

To conjugate a future tense verb, we have a verb stem and we add the endings (which look very similar to the verb AVOIR (to have)).

Here are the verb endings:
