

# PRESENT TENSE IN FRENCH

## - irregular verbs

### When to use it:

- when you would normally say “I have...” or “I do have...” or “I am having...” in English

### Common Irregular Verbs: avoir, être, aller and faire

Some French verbs are irregular, which means that they have a special conjugation – they do not follow the usual pattern. The verbs **avoir**, **être**, **aller** and **faire** are irregular and are some of the most common verbs in French, meaning that it is important to learn their conjugation by heart. The table below shows the present tense conjugation of these irregular verbs.

Person	avoir to have	être to be	aller to go	faire to do/make
1 <sup>st</sup> person singular ( <i>I</i> )	j' <b>ai</b>	je <b>suis</b>	je <b>vais</b>	je <b>fais</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> person singular ( <i>you</i> )	tu <b>as</b>	tu <b>es</b>	tu <b>vas</b>	tu <b>fais</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup> person singular ( <i>he/she/it</i> )	il/elle/on <b>a</b>	il/elle/on <b>est</b>	il/elle/on <b>va</b>	il/elle/on <b>fait</b>
1 <sup>st</sup> person plural ( <i>we</i> )	nous <b>avons</b>	nous <b>sommes</b>	nous <b>allons</b>	nous <b>faisons</b>
2 <sup>nd</sup> person plural ( <i>you</i> )	vous <b>avez</b>	vous <b>êtes</b>	vous <b>allez</b>	vous <b>faites</b>
3 <sup>rd</sup> person plural ( <i>they</i> )	ils/elles <b>ont</b>	ils/elles <b>sont</b>	ils/elles <b>vont</b>	ils/elles <b>font</b>

You need to spend time learning these: repeat them several times over, or stick a copy to your bedroom wall/mirror, or write on post-it notes and only take them down when you can recite each one...

### Not sure if a verb is regular or irregular?

Most verbs are REGULAR and you will start to spot the irregular ones if you commit them to memory. You can also use a verb table (in a dictionary or online, such as [www.wordreference.com](http://www.wordreference.com) or <https://français.lingolia.com/en/grammar/conjugator>).

Here are some more irregular French verbs;

acheter	to buy	prendre	to take
boire	to drink	rire	to laugh
dire	to say	savoir	to know (a fact)
jeter	to throw	tenir	to hold
mettre	to put (on)	venir	to come
offrir	to offer	voir	to see
